The 87th International Session of the EYP will be held Vilnius, Lithuania between 14th and 22nd of July, 2018. The Call for the Editor(s) is now out. You can read the Message from the NOC below. Please note that the size of the Media Team is yet to be determined and could be smaller than the standard one with 15 Journalists and 1-2 Editorial Assistants. Message from the NOC

2018 will mark the 100 year anniversary of the independence of Lithuania, thus the theme “Learning from the Past, Shaping the Future” was chosen in order to highlight the connection between this historical event and the International Session, as well as to provide the participants with a platform to rethink the past occurrences in their academic work.

The Head-Organisers would like to welcome an Editor who would be able to design the media concept and produce the visual output with respect to the theme of the event and academic programme.

We are searching for an individual who will lead a team of wonderful and creative people ready to brighten-up long hours of committee work, create digital memories and combine academics and fun in pre-, mid-, and post-session projects.

The general session programme will reflect the overarching theme as well, as it will be designed to present Lithuania's shift to an open, innovative and business-friendly country during its independence, as well as to introduce the historical and cultural heritage of Lithuania to the participants.

Furthermore, we aim to create a working environment based on the observations of both pleasant and uncomfortable experiences of participants. As the Officials Team will be an experienced one, the Editor as well as the President, and later on the other members of the session leadership are anticipated to gather and share what they have learnt from the past and how this affects shaping the future.

Selection criteria

According to [EYP policies](#), the Editor of an International Session has to meet the following criteria:

- i. Excellent English language skills;
- ii. Good knowledge of and interest in European issues;
- iii. High sense of responsibility, expressed motivation and commitment to further EYP's objectives;
- iv. Previous group facilitation and EYP experience;
- v. Good planning and organisational skills;
- vi. Ability to lead a group and good understanding of group dynamics;



- vii. Ability to work as a member of a team and with individuals from various cultural and socio-economic backgrounds;
- viii. Creativity and personal vision for the role desirable.
- ix. A clear vision and plan for the media team and its output;
- x. Excellent leadership skills and understanding of group dynamics;
- xi. Creativity in all aspects of the work of the media team;
- xii. Previous media team experience;
- xiii. Ability to critically assess contemporary media production technologies.

The Selection Panel will consider first the individuals who have applied for the position and thereby thoroughly go over all the applications, following the guidelines given by the Governing Body.

The Selection Panel will consist of a designated member of the NOC Gintarė Valėnaitė (LT), past session Editor Giada Benfatto (FR) and a member of the Governing Body Noura Berrouba (SE).

According to [the Policy on the Selection of International Session Officials](#) to be eligible for selection, the applicant needs to have at least one official EYP evaluation.

How to apply?

If you are available and interested in attending, you should follow these steps to apply:

1. Log on to the EYP Member Platform (if you do not have access or encounter any other problems with the platform, please, get in touch with support@eyp.org);
2. Update your personal profile on the platform. Please, make sure your full name, country, home National Committee, session history and contact information are available and updated.
3. Apply for the 87th International Session in Vilnius as Editor on the [Event's Page on the Member Platform](#) and fill in the questions (questions are listed below).
4. The deadline for submitting your application on the platform is **Monday, 19th of February at 12:00 (noon) CET**.

All officials are also asked to make sure they are aware of the relevant policies of the EYP as listed in the official EYP Info Section on the Member Platform <https://www.members.eyp.org/structure-and-policies>.

Application questions

1. Explain how you fulfil the criteria for the position you are applying for and support your reasoning with concrete examples. (max 250 words)
2. Identify and discuss your key strengths and weaknesses as an Editor and how you intend to work on the latter at the session. (max 250 words)



3. Explain how a media team led by you would contribute to the academic and social experience of the participants of the International Session in Vilnius by outlining your vision and concrete ideas for the media team and its output.

The selection will only begin once the application deadline is over. All the applicants will be informed individually about the outcome of the selection process.
